The Travel & Tourism sector is taking important steps towards greater sustainability and net-zero operations. To reach this vision, the World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC), together with leading hotel groups and destination authorities have worked hand in hand to identify the first crucial sustainable steps that all properties around the world, whatever their size, can and should take and thereby raise the bar of sustainability in Travel & Tourism overall. We can truly say that Hotel Sustainability Basics is a globally recognized set of sustainability indicators for hotels, developed by the industry for the industry.

Mirabilis Boutique Hotel adopted this framework and we have committed to net-zero by 2050 and set our emission reduction targets based on climate science. To reach this ambitious mid-term decarbonization target, Mirabilis Boutique Hotel has set intermediate targets. The implementation of the Hotel Sustainability Basics in our hotels is the main way to approach sustainability. The following infographic summarizes out targets and actions.

Efficiency

We are committed to measuring and reducing energy and water consumption, waste and carbon emissions by:

Improving the energy efficiency of our buildings and controlling the water consumption helps us to reduce the ecological footprint of our hotel. One of the concrete steps we took are the installation of solar panels on the roof of the building for renewable energy supply and the selection of energy efficient equipment.

Mirabilis Boutique Hotel has set a target of reducing its carbon emissions by 30% by 2035. CO₂ emissions are continuously monitored by the certified platform Ecohotel

We promote better **waste management** by sorting waste, eliminating singleuse plastics and reducing food waste.
